- Be eligible for permanent employment in the U.S.

- Comfortable with both ambiguity/innovation and standard processes
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Strong problem-solving skills
- Leadership skills/experience
- Business sense/strategic thinking
- Willing to relocate if needed

EDGE interns will be competitively paid, and will be able to use the generous employee discount on the newest and coolest technology that we sell in our stores. Interns will be responsible for covering any travel, relocation and housing expenses.
